Hazard: Faulty Equipment Risk: Minor injury (cuts and abrasions)	Participants	Equipment stored correctly and inspected before use	Instructor	
Hazard: Risk of Rebound Risk: Minor injury (cuts and abrasions)	Participants	Shooting position must be at an acceptable distance from target face. The backstop is inspected for wear and tear. Shooters and Instructors must wear ear safety goggles.	Instructor	
Hazard: Shooting control Risk: Minor / major injury	Participants	Induction to activity and ongoing supervision by qualified instructor	Instructor	
Hazard: Range Layout Risk: minor injury (eye / body / head)	Participants	The range must be secured and laid out in accordance with Scout P.O.R. The range must be regularly inspected for compliance	Instructor	
Hazard: Collection of targets after shooting Risk: minor / major injury	Participants	No participants to cross the firing line All shooting must be completed All rifles must be unloaded and broken and laid down on the shooting bench Shooters must wait until the all clear has been given before retrieving targets. No shooting must recommence until new targets have been positioned and all shooters are back on the safe side of the firing line.
