Gladiators Risk Assessment

HAZARD	WHO MIGHT BE HARMED	RISK LEVEL	CONTROL OF RISK
Injury by sharp objects	Participants	Low	Activity must be supervised by a competent adult at all times. All sharp objects to be removed from pockets prior to use. Spectacles, watches and shoes to be removed prior to use.
Injury from playing the game	Participants	Low	Only 2 participants in the arena at any one time. Participants must wear protective headwear. Horseplay or over exuberant play must not be tolerated.
Being hit by falling participant	Spectators and Supervisors	Low	Supervision by competent adults. Spectators to be kept at least 1 metre away from the blow-up arena.
Poor weather conditions	Participants	Moderate	Gladiator arena to be securely pegged to the ground. Gladiator activity not to be used in poor weather conditions Should weather become inclement during the usage then the activity must be stopped and the inflation turned off particularly high winds, heavy rain or snow.

Rules of Operation

Prior permission must be gained before using this equipment.

This activity must always be supervised by a responsible adult.

Use of the activity must cease if weather conditions deteriorate.

Participants must remove spectacles, watches, shoes and sharp objects from pockets.

Participants must wear the padded helmets provided by the site.

A prohibited area at least 1 metre outside the arena will be established; area to be defined by blue rope.

Spectators must be kept outside the prohibited area.

Only two persons to be on the arena at any one time.

Horseplay or over exuberant play must not be tolerated.
