# CHANCE TO HAVE YOUR SAY ON UNIFORM

In February, Girlguiding will introduce a set of activities for each section to help volunteers and girls of all ages to feed into the design. #### **DUKE OF EDINBURGH**

Do you have girls who are thinking about doing their Duke of Edinburgh's award? Did you know you can do it through Girlguiding? It is an internationally recognised programme available to 14 to 24 and is an opportunity to discover new interests and talents, gain essential life skills and have fun. There are three levels available:

- Bronze for those aged 14 to 24 or 13 and in the school year when you turn 14, takes at least six months
- Silver for those aged 15 to 24 or 14 and in the school year when you turn 15, takes at least six months if you've completed Bronze or twelve months as a direct entrant to Silver
- Gold for those aged 16 to 24, takes at least twelve months if you've completed Silver or at least eighteen months as a direct entrant to Gold

**Leaders** – there's also the opportunity for girls and young women who are not involved in Guiding to do the Volunteering section of the D of E award with us. Particularly at Bronze and Silver, D of E is often run in schools so it's worth reaching out to your local school if need volunteers.
