#### **MEMBERSHIP SUBSCRIPTIONS**

Membership subscription trial invoices are available to view and download from the Subscriptions system.

#### Unit leaders should:

- Check unit invoices and look at numbers of girls and volunteers to be paid for.
- Update records for girls who have left and ensure all girls attending meetings are recorded on GO.
- Ensure there will be sufficient cleared funds in unit accounts to pay invoices promptly.

7pm, Mon 19 Feb: No more changes can be made to trial invoices.

**Noon, Tues 20 Feb**: Official and payable invoices will be available to download and send with payment. **Noon, Thurs 28 Mar**: All subscription payments must be received in full by this date.

Payments can be made by debit card or cheque with 2 signatories - <u>no personal cheques will be accepted</u>. Please arrange to meet with your secondary signatory now if you don't see each other very often. ### **COMMONWEALTH AWARD**

The Commonwealth award is open to Guides aged 13 and over, Rangers, young leaders and adult members aged 18-25 in all Commonwealth countries. The award will help you discover more about Girlguiding as well the Commonwealth.

You can complete this award by yourself or with your peers. There is no time limit. You must undertake three compulsory challenges (history of guiding, knowledge of commonwealth and community action), along with 2 optional challenges (from health, environment, culture heritage, fit for life, out of door, public speaking/debating, creative writing, citizenship and investigation).

It is one of the more uncommon awards and there have been less than 5 presented in Leeds County over the last 5 years. Let us know <u>here</u> when you start working on the award. Once complete, let the county team know and they can arrange its presentation.
